Dear Parents and Carers of Wynnum State School students,

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION

After consultation with the school leadership team, we, your P&C are asking for a voluntary contribution to offset some of the non-funded cost of consumables associated with your child's education.

Your contribution will be used to supplement Education Queensland funds and our regular \$30,000 donation towards the delivery of a quality curriculum based education for your children. Some of the specific areas in which your contribution will assist are: -

- Costs of photocopying for material used in class daily and for correspondence with yourselves
- Enhancements to both the music and arts programs available to all students
- Materials associated with the use of technology resources within the school including internet access fees and printing items

In addition to these items there are also various other expenses relating specifically to each year level to facilitate your child's participation in a range of other activities and events. We are suggesting an appropriate amount of \$60 per school family or \$40 for a single child but in fact, any contribution would be greatly appreciated.
