Our initiatives include

- Implement professional learning teams as part of our whole school development as a professional learning community
- Support fidelity of implementation of Australian Curriculum across the three levels of planning with the engagement of a Head of Department Curriculum (HOD-C)
- Seek clarity, knowledge and engagement for all learners through Knowing our Students, Knowing our Teaching Practices and Knowing our Community, as detailed in the Wynnum State School 2022 Annual Implementation Plan (AIP)

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Focus the Wynnum SS professional learning community to continually prioritise 'the right work' of improving student outcomes. Funding for ongoing professional learning of staff: \$126 891
- Release of teaching teams each term to plan and moderate collaboratively, supported by HOD-C. Funding for engagement of HOD-C and replacement of teachers planning together each term: \$40 000
- Analysis of school based and systemic data by professional learning teams, to focus on good first teaching for all and focused and intensive intervention where necessary. Funding for school support staff to support AIP initiatives and achieve targets, including additional Speech Language Pathologist support: \$158 428
